Ted has produced, played guitar, arranged, recorded, & toured with major artists Whitney Houston, Harry Belafonte, Bob Dylan, Diana Ross, Burt Bacharach, Ronald Isley, Alessandra Rosaldo, The Manhattans, Blush, Ringo, Joe Cocker, Chicago, rapper Young M.C., Jonathan Richman, Willie Colon & Hector Lavoe, Imelda Papin, Dr. Buzzard's Savannah Band, & Engelbert Humperdink. All this has made Ted proficient in a variety of musical styles - R&B, Rock, Hip-Hop, Soul, Classical, Pop, Latin, Rap, Country, World, etc. Originally from New York, he now lives in L.A.

He has done extensive work in TV & Movies. He arranged, programmed, & recorded 3 songs in the Adam Sandler

movie "I Now Pronounce You Chuck And Larry", ft. Lance Bass of *NSYNC. Ted produced the song "Before We Say Goodbye" for MTV's "2gether", produced, played, & composed the score for the ABC-TV "World Stunt Awards", co-wrote the main theme & cues for Showtime's "Full Frontal Comedy" (winner of Cable ACE award for Best Stand Up Comedy), co-produced 2 songs in the Ellen Burstyn film "Walking Across Egypt", & produced the title song for Jean-Claude Van Damme's film "Desert Heat". Ted has conducted, played guitar, & arranged music for NBC, CBS, ABC, Fox, & others. He has done jingles for McDonald's, Applebee's, Burger King, Korean Airlines, Perrier, & Coca-Cola.

He is a Pro endorser/consultant featured in ads by major companies Celemony, Sony Digital, Trident Speakers, Steinberg, Dean Markley Strings, PSP, Brauner-Sontronics-ADK-Studio Projects-Pearlman mics, Native Instruments, LinPlug, ikMultimedia, Rob Papan, X-Hun Audio, Frontier, Audio Technica, & Full Compass Audio among many others. He writes for music magazines including "Computer Music" & was the subject of the first podcast by "Electronic Musician". Celemony & Trident both filmed interviews with Ted at his studio "The Ranch" in Los Angeles.

New projects are producing the new solo CD "Alessandra" by Mexican superstar Alessandra Rosaldo (who has career CD sales totalling almost 10 million), a new release from The Manhattan Transfer, Dave Mason's "26 Letters, 12 Notes", "God's Gardeners" - a new CD of award winning internationally famed author Margaret Atwood, the first CD by 12-year old guitarist/singer Gypsy Rose, country singer Tesa James (relative of famed outlaw Jesse James), A*TEENS star Sara Lumholdt, pop legend Neil

Sedaka's latest release (featuring producers David Foster & Ted), Mexican rock-en-Espanol star Roberto Enrique, Bob Geldoff vocalist Zara, "Gospel Record & Song Of The Year" Unity Award winning Catholic artist Valimar Jansen, the new solo CD from longtime Manhattan Transfer member Alan Paul, a new CD from "Jersey Boys" Tony winner John Lloyd Young, a new release from rock legend Benny Mardones, and Filipino singing superstar Imelda Papin. He programmed, arranged, & recorded the top-five platinum selling UK singles "Paradise" and "I Think I Love You" for Curb Records' singer Kaci. He produced & wrote the #1 European charting CD "Livin' On Love" for American Idol's "Vocal Coach From Hell" Peggi Blu.

Ted won a Grammy for his work on "At This Time" by Burt Bacharach, & co-produced with Burt a song on Ronald Isley's CD "Here I Am". On "New Music From An Old Friend", Ted played the guitar solo on Brian Wilson's "What Love Can Do" & co-produced "Still Remember" with Burt Bacharach. He mixed "The 5 Browns" duet w/ Dean Martin of "Everybody Loves Somebody" (which went to #1 TWICE in Billboard). Ted is currently in production with actress/singer Gloria Loring (Robin Thicke's mom) on her new CD, and also working on a new CD for music icon (& Blues Brothers agent Morty Sline) Steve Lawrence with guests including country music superstars Garth Brooks & Trisha Yearwood.
