She is one of approximately 400 board-certified veterinary specialists in medical oncology in North America. Dr. Avey received her undergraduate and veterinary degree from Colorado State University College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. She became board certified and the first female African-American veterinary medical oncologist in 2005.
